SPECIFIC PROVISIONS FOR THE ACCREDITATION OF CERTIFICATION BODIES IN THE FIELD OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS (ISO 45001)

This document is intended to document the specific requirements and guidelines that shall apply for the accreditation of certification bodies in the field of Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems (ISO 45001).

It includes in particular:

- The specific requirements and guidelines related to the organization and operation of the certification body;
- The specific requirements and guidelines applicable to BELAC.

The specific requirements and guidelines for the direct performance of the conformity assessment activities are not detailed in the present document but a reference to the relevant documents is included.

The specific requirements and guidelines complement the requirements and guidelines that are in force to all BELAC accreditation activities.

National legislation will prevail in case of conflict with this document.

Although IAF MD 22 is not fully reflected in this document, it is fully applicable.
