## Federated Register

On the website of the EPO, [www.epo.org](http://www.epo.org), in the section "European Patent Register" or use the link: [bit.ly/epo-search-en](http://bit.ly/epo-search-en)

The consultation is free and no registration is needed.



The Federated Register of the European Patent Register of the EPO allows you to see the current status of a European patent in each of the EPO member states (including Belgium), that are affiliated to the EPO.

## What does it contain?

Information on data provided by each national patent office and currently included in the Federated Register, such as:

- the status of a European patent in a member state;
- the application number;
- the publication number;
- the holder of the invention;
- the expiration or due date of the patent;
- the date of the last payment of renewal fees;
- the date of the last update of the national register.

## When to use the Federated Register?

Get immediate access to the key information about a European patent in the different member states it designates. The Federated Register provides a single point of access that leads directly to the national online patent registers of the EPO member states.
